



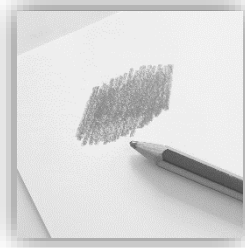

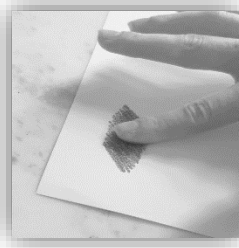


Items you will need

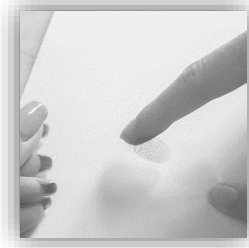
1. A 3B soft pencil
2. Sticky clear tape
3. Plain white paper



Use a pencil to colour in a section on white plain paper. Colour in a section that is bigger than the fingerprint you wish to take the impression of. Shade over the same section several times.



With clean and dry hands, roll a finger onto the pencil coloured section for a few seconds.



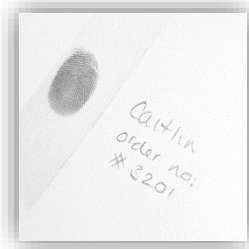
Once there is a generous amount of graphite on the finger, place it onto sticky tape on the sticky side. Make sure that this is performed on a level and firm surface. The fingerprint should transfer and appear on the tape.



Repeat this process to obtain as many prints as you like. We recommend using the index finger as the detail tends to be more defined. If you feel there is more definition on other fingers please do try these too.



Check the print. You are looking for clear lines with the impression not too light or dark. Try making lighter fingerprints by taking several prints without refreshing the pencil on your finger.



Turn the tape over and stick it onto a white piece of paper and add the name of the person the print belongs to.
